The Characteristics of Social and Religious Rituals

A ritual is an organised pattern of symbolic actions and words (things we do and say) which members of a community use to understand and act out important experiences. Rituals can be a part of everyday life, they can have a regular place and meaning in special events and it can be an action that has a regular place in worship. Rituals can be social, such as the celebration of Anzac Day in Australia and New Zealand or Religious, such as the celebration of the Washing of the Feet at the Holy Thursday Mass in Catholicism each Easter.
